NEXT GENERATION MEN OF TRANSITION



Educator, Activist, Advocate, Public Speaker, and 1st openly Black Transgender candidate for City Council in Western New York (Rochester, NY 2021). Hardgers vowed in 2018 to bring visibility to the Trans Masculine community of Rochester. Upon starting his own physical transition (FTM), Hardgers founded Next Generation Men of Transition which built another channel of national support for Trans Masc folks. Growing this brotherhood within the LGBTQ+ community provided many forms of support. Through NGMT, Hardgers facilitates support groups, mutual aid, emergency assistance, resources, social justice reform and education for and surrounding men of transition within organizations all over the country. Brittan has participated in many educational panels nationwide, including: Emory University, GEVA Theatre, University of Rochester, Rochester Public Defender's Office, Wind Stream, Aria Strategies and many more. Currently, Brittan is the VP of the Greater Rochester LGBTQ+ Political Caucus, CEO of W.A.V.E Women Inc, Co-Creative Director of Cover Design for Blaque/Out Magazine as well as the creator of its column, TRAN/s/. Brittan is also the self-published author of "Uniquely Made By You" Affirmation Journal. Hardgers delivered the keynote speech for the City of Rochester sponsored TDOR event in 2019 and hosted the event in 2020, 2021 & 2022. Since 2018, Brittan (NGMT) also continues to host an annual TDOV event on March 31st.

In honor of Trans Day of Remembrance 2022, Brittan created "Remember Me Now", a documentary uplifting Transgender voices across the nation. Brittan is currently the Patient Centered Care Officer/Ombudsperson at the University Of Rochester Medical Center.


